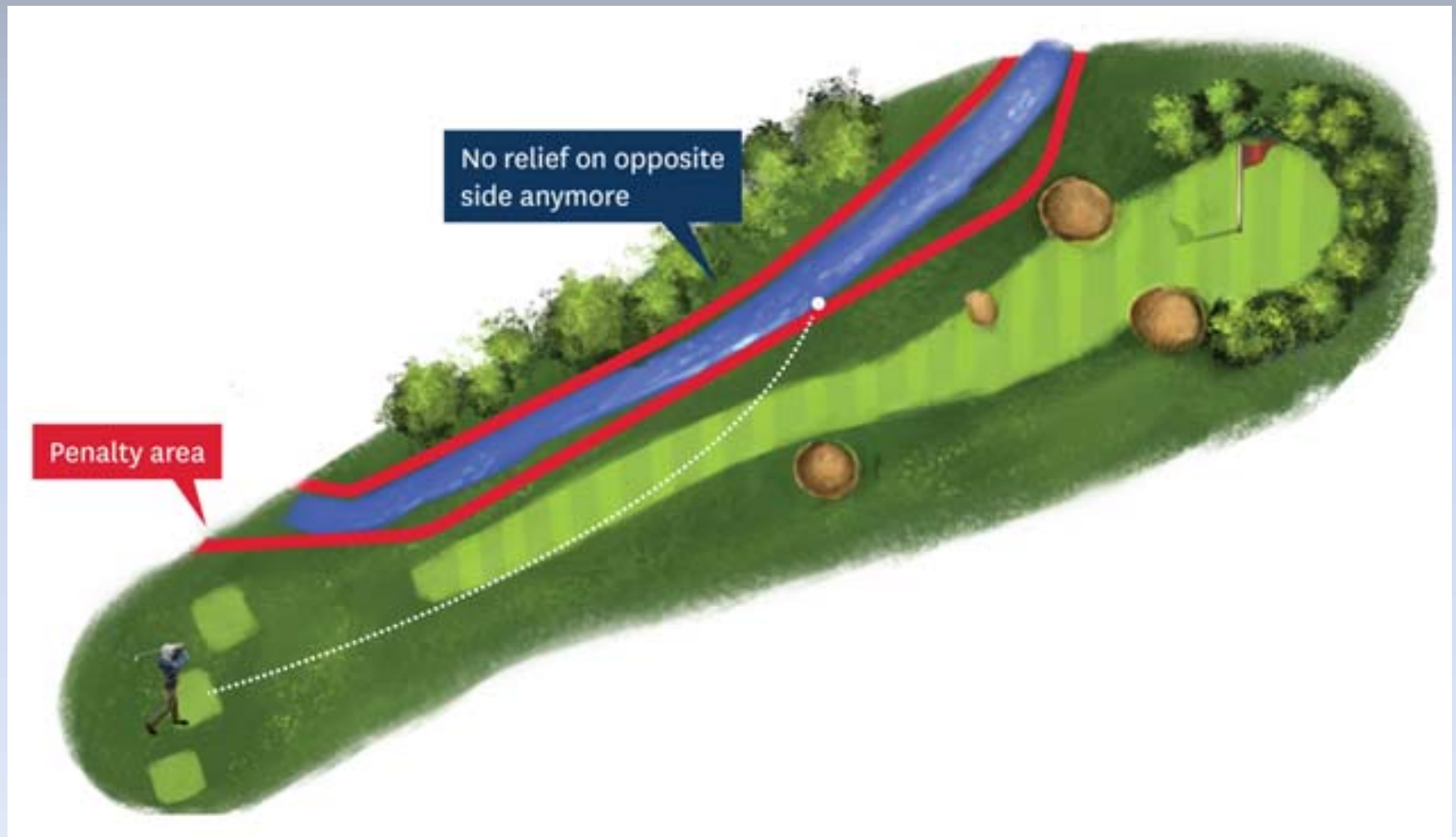

Dropping Procedure

OLD



NEW

Old

- Ball may roll up to two club lengths

New

- Ball must remain in designated area

How to Drop a Ball

You will drop your ball from knee height into the relief area.



New Local Rule – Stroke and Distance



Lost Ball? 3 minutes



Lost Ball? No penalty if ball moved
