The Process:

- Started at -5mm (-.2")
 - Adjusted to -10mm (-.4")
 - Settled on -20mm (-.8")
- Took roughly two hours to do 22,000 ft²
- Day 1:
 - Dragged debris, mowed at .450" to cut remaining material, applied 15-0-15 w/ Ronstar @ 1#N/m



The Process:

- Day 2: Applied TopChoice @ 87#/ac
- Day 8 & 15: Mowed at .450"
- Day 10: Topdressed tee heavy and dragged in
- Day 13: Started weekly foliar sprays
- Day 18: Resumed regular mowing
- Day 28: Reopened tee



What I would do different:

- Fertilize one week prior with $\frac{1}{2}\#N/m$ using quick release fertilizer to stimulate plant growth
- More hands on deck during process
- Have someone else clean-up debris piles
 - Two hours to make the mess, two days to clean it up
- Core aerify after
- Communicate with membership the process and initial results
